

DMCA Notice & Takedown Policy

FX Broker Fraud (“we”, “us”, “our”) respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects our users to do the same. This DMCA Notice & Takedown Policy explains how to report copyright infringement and how we handle such reports.

1. Introduction

Under the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA), copyright owners who believe their rights have been infringed online may submit a formal notice requesting that infringing material be removed or access to it disabled.

We respond to valid DMCA notices and take appropriate action, which may include:

- Removing or disabling access to the identified content
- Terminating repeat infringers
- Notifying the user responsible for the content

2. Filing a DMCA Takedown Notice

If you believe copyrighted material has been used on our Site without permission, you may submit a DMCA Takedown Notice to our Designated Agent at:

sales@fxbrokerfraud.com

To be valid, your notice **must include** the following information as required by 17 U.S.C. § 512(c) (3):

1. A physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or the owner’s authorized agent.
2. Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed.
3. Identification of the material that is allegedly infringing, including enough detail for us to locate it.
4. Your contact information, including:
 - Full name
 - Email address
 - Phone number
 - Mailing address
5. A statement that you have a **good-faith belief** that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.
6. A statement that the information in your notice is accurate, and **under penalty of perjury**, that you are the copyright owner or are authorized to act on the copyright owner’s behalf.

Incomplete or invalid notices may not be processed.

3. What Happens After You Submit a DMCA Notice

Once we receive a valid DMCA Notice:

- We will review the claim.
- We may remove or disable access to the allegedly infringing material.
- We may notify the user who posted the content, providing them with a copy of your notice.
- If the user disputes your claim, they may file a **DMCA Counter-Notice** (see Section 4).

We may, but are not required to, forward your notice to external anti-piracy services or legal authorities if warranted.

4. Filing a DMCA Counter-Notice

If content you posted was removed due to a DMCA Notice and you believe the removal was a mistake or you are legally authorized to use the content, you may submit a Counter-Notice to: sales@fxbrokerfraud.com

Your Counter-Notice must include:

1. Your physical or electronic signature.
2. Identification of the removed content and the location before removal.
3. A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good-faith belief the content was removed by mistake or misidentification.
4. Your name, address, phone number, and email address.
5. A statement consenting to the jurisdiction of the courts in your legal jurisdiction (or the jurisdiction of FX Broker Fraud, if applicable) and agreeing to accept service of process from the complaining copyright owner or their agent.

Upon receiving a valid Counter-Notice:

- We may restore the content unless the complaining party files legal action within the required timeframe (typically 10–14 business days).

5. Repeat Infringer Policy

FX Broker Fraud enforces a **zero-tolerance policy** for repeat copyright infringers.

Users who repeatedly upload or distribute infringing content may have their accounts suspended or permanently terminated.

6. Misrepresentation Warning

Under the DMCA, anyone who knowingly submits a false copyright claim or false Counter-Notice may be liable for damages, including attorney's fees and costs.

Submitting fraudulent or abusive notices may result in legal consequences.

7. International Users

Although the DMCA is a U.S. law, this policy applies to all users globally.

Users outside the United States must understand that DMCA procedures may involve legal jurisdictions beyond their own.
